AN ACT to authorise the Borrowing of a sum not exceeding Ten thousand Pounds, and the Application thereof for the purpose of constructing and extending Cool Storage Facilities.

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** This Act may be cited as the *Loan (Provision of Cool Stores) Act 1941.* Short title.

*Loan (Provision of Cool Stores).*

A.D. 1941. **2** The Treasurer may raise, borrow, and receive a sum not exceeding ten thousand pounds to meet the cost of the construction and extension of cool storage facilities as provided by this Act.

**3**—(1) The amount raised under this Act shall be applied by the Minister—

- I. In or towards the construction and extension of cool storage facilities in such places as he may think necessary; or
- II. By way of loans to approved persons for the purpose of the construction and extension of cool storage facilities.

(2) The application by the Minister of the moneys so raised shall be subject to such conditions and restrictions as he may require, or as may be prescribed.

Regulations.

**4** The Governor may make regulations for the purposes of this Act.
