# AN ACT to amend the Law Reform Commission Act 1974. [1 October 1975]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Law Reform Commission Short title and Act 1975.
- (2) The Law Reform Commission Act 1974 is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Establishment of Law Reform Commission of Tasmania. **2** Section 3 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (2) (a) the words "judge of the Supreme Court of Tasmania" and substituting the words "practitioner, a former judge of the Supreme Court of Tasmania, or a former practitioner".

Services to be provided by the Secretary, Attorney-General's Department, and other assistance.

**3** Section 10 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the word "Solicitor-General" from subsections (1) and (2) (wherever occurring) and substituting the words "Secretary, Attorney-General's Department" in each case.
