AN ACT to amend the Land Surveyors Act 1909. [28 November, 1945.]

B^E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Land Surveyors Act Short title and citation.
- (2) The Land Surveyors Act 1909*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Constitution of Surveyors' Board.

- **2** Section four of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsection (4) and substituting therefor the following subsection:—
- "(4) The Surveyor-General shall, by virtue of his office, be a member of the Board and shall be the President thereof.".

Examina-

- 3 Section nine of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after subsection (2) the following subsection:—
 - "(2A) The Board may conduct examinations in—
 - I. Survey draftsmanship: and
- II. The principles relating to the valuation of land, and may grant certificates of competency to persons who pass such examinations.".

Surveyors to correct errors at their own expense.

4 Section sixteen of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the words "Permanent Head of the Lands and Surveys Department", wherever occurring, in subsection (1) and substituting therefor the words "Surveyor-General".

By-laws.

- **5** Section twenty-four of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after paragraph v. of subsection (1) the following paragraph:—
 - "VA. Regulating the conduct of examinations for the purposes of subsection (2A) of section nine, and the granting of certificates of competency to persons who pass such examinations, and prescribing courses of study for, and the conditions applicable to, such examinations: ".
