

Observance of holiday. **3**—(1) The ninth day of May, 1951 (in this Act referred to as “the said day”) shall be—

- (a) known as the Commonwealth Jubilee Holiday;
- (b) observed throughout the State as a public holiday; and
- (c) deemed, for all purposes, to be a bank holiday throughout the State, as if it had been so appointed pursuant to the provisions of the *Bank Holidays Act 1919*.*

(2) Notwithstanding anything contained in the *Wages Boards Act 1920*,† the said day shall be deemed to be a holiday on full pay for the purposes of every determination under that Act as if it were expressly prescribed in the determination as a holiday on full pay; and, notwithstanding the provisions of the said Act or of any such determination, every employee to whom any such determination relates shall be allowed a holiday with full pay on the said day or shall, if he is not allowed a holiday on that day, receive such extra or special payment as is prescribed in the determination in respect of work done on holidays.

(3) Any employer who fails to allow any person employed by him a holiday on full pay on the said day or, if the person so employed is not allowed a holiday on that day, fails to pay that person at the appropriate rate of payment in respect of work done on holidays, as prescribed in the determination which is applicable to the employment, shall be liable to a penalty of five pounds.

LATROBE SEWERAGE.

AN ACT to amend the *Latrobe Sewerage Act 1948*.
[1 May, 1951.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Latrobe Sewerage Act 1951*.

(2) The *Latrobe Sewerage Act 1948** is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section three of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (a) of subsection (1) the word “thirty” and substituting therefor the word “sixty”; and
- (b) by omitting from paragraph (b) of that subsection the word “twenty” and substituting therefor the word “forty”.
