AN ACT to amend the Law Society Act 1962 for the purpose of making amendments that are consequential to the Legal Practitioners Amendment Act 1980.

[Royal Assent 2 September 1980]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Law Society Amendment Act* Short title. 1980.

2—This Act shall commence on the date on which the *Legal Practitioners Amendment Act 1980* commences. Commencement.

3—Section 16 (2) of the *Law Society Act 1962** is amended as follows:—

- (a) by omitting “ of this section ” and substituting “, section 58B (5) of the *Legal Practitioners Act 1959*, or clause 4 (2) of Schedule 1 to the *Legal Practitioners Amendment Act 1980* ”;
- (b) by omitting from paragraph (a) “ a practitioner ” and substituting “ the practitioner, or the names of the practitioners,”;
- (c) by inserting in paragraphs (b) and (c) “ or them ” after “ him ”, wherever occurring.
