AN ACT to amend the Long Service Leave (Casual Employment) Act 1971. [4 October 1973.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Long Service Leave (Casual Short title and Employment) Act (No. 2) 1973.
- (2) The Long Service Leave (Casual Employment) Act 1971, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Amendment to second schedule.

2 The second schedule to the Principal Act is amended by adding after item 5 in Part I, the following item:—

"6. Absence from work of an employee on a public holiday in accordance with the terms and conditions of his service.".
