AN ACT to amend the Long Service Leave (Construction Industry) Act 1971.

[Royal Assent 28 November 1986]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Long Service Leave (Construction Industry) Amendment Act 1986*. Short title.

2—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives the Royal assent. Commencement.

Principal Act. **3**—In this Act, the *Long Service Leave (Construction Industry) Act 1971** is referred to as the Principal Act.

Amendment of section 9 of Principal Act (Entitlement to long service leave payments).

4—Section 9 of the Principal Act is amended as follows:—

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (b) of subsection (6) “ of ” and substituting “ for ”;
- (b) by inserting after subsection (6) the following subsection:—

(6A) For the purposes of subsection (6) (b), an employee who terminates his employment on or after becoming eligible for a service pension under section 84 of the *Repatriation Act 1920* of the Commonwealth shall be deemed to have attained the age for retirement.

Amendment of section 12c of Principal Act (Return of long service leave contributed in certain cases).

5—Section 12c of the Principal Act is amended as follows:—

- (a) by omitting from subparagraph (ii) of subsection (1) (b) “ of ” and substituting “ for ”;
- (b) by adding after subsection (2) the following subsection:—

(3) For the purposes of subsection (1) (b), an employee who terminates his employment on or after becoming eligible for a service pension under section 84 of the *Repatriation Act 1920* of the Commonwealth shall be deemed to have attained the age for retirement.
