AN ACT to amend the Land Valuation Act 1909. [25 November, 1943.]

**B**<sup>E</sup> it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:---

**1** This Act may be cited as the Land Valuation Act (No. 2) <sub>Short title.</sub> 1943.

**2** The Land Valuation Act 1942 is hereby amended by Amendment inserting after the end of division (b) of paragraph I. of sub- ${}^{of}_{VL}$  No. 60, section (2) of section two thereof (in alignment with the com-s. 2. mencement of that paragraph) the words "and in any case where the Minister is satisfied that owing to a mistake or error of judgment any property has been substantially over-valued or under-valued and that it is just and reasonable that it should be re-valued" and by deleting the word "and" immediately following division (b) of the said paragraph I.
