LATROBE WATER.

No. 62 of 1948.

AN ACT to amend the Latrobe Water Act 1943. [15 December, 1948.]

B^E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and citation. **1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Latrobe Water Act 1948.

(2) The Latrobe Water Act 1943^* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 The title of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the words "and elsewhere within the Municipality of Latrobe.".

3 Section three of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by inserting after the definition of "Domestic purposes" the following definitions:---
 - "'Latrobe Town Water District' means the district defined in the second schedule, together with such and less such areas as the Council of the Municipality may from time to time by resolution published in the *Gazette* declare to be added to or excluded from the Latrobe Town Water District:
 - 'Municipality' means the Municipality of Latrobe:
 - 'Rural Water District' means any water district within the Municipality but beyond the Latrobe Town Water District which may be defined and constituted under the Local Government Act 1906⁺; and
- (b) by omitting from the definition of "Water District" all the words from and including the word "means" and substituting therefor the words "includes the Latrobe Town Water District and every Rural Water District".

5 Section fifteen of the Principal Act is repealed and the following section is substituted therefor:---

"15. The Council, in its absolute discretion and on such Supply of terms and conditions as it may see fit, may extend beyond the Latrob Latrobe Town Water District or beyond a Rural Water Dis-trict any of the water mains within such district and thereby Rural Water supply water to any other or others of such disticts, or, upon application of the owner or occupier of any dwelling-house, building, or premises, to any place not within a water district as the Council may see fit.".

6 Section twenty-four of the Principal Act is amended by Separate omitting from subsections (3) and (4) the words "the water limited to district" and substituting therefor the words "a water dis- two shillings and sixpence. trict".

CROWN LANDS (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) (No. 2).

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Crown Lands (Miscel-short title, citation, and incorporation laneous Provisions) (No. 2) Act 1948.

(2) This Act shall be incorporated with the Crown Lands Act 1935*, in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
