AN ACT to amend the *Mining Act* 1929.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Mining Act* 1937.

Short title.

2 The Principal Act is hereby amended—

1. By inserting the words—

(a) “barytes, phosphate rock” after “porphyry” in the definition of “stone” in section two ;

(b) “or a special prospecting licence” at the end of paragraph iv. of subsection (2) of section thirteen :

(c) “(1)” at the commencement, and the following new subsection (2)—

“(2) With the consent, in writing, of the owner and occupier respectively or upon obtaining a permit as prescribed from a warden for that purpose, and upon payment or security for compensation in manner provided by section seventy-three, the holder of a miner’s right may exercise the powers conferred by subsection (1) hereof in respect of private land subject to any conditions which may be prescribed.”,

at the end of section sixteen—

II. As to section thirty-one thereof—

(a) By deleting “stone” in subsection (2): and

(b) By inserting “or stone” after “minerals” in that subsection :

III. By inserting “mining products whencesoever obtained” (after “deposit” in paragraph iii. of section sixty-nine thereof) :

Section 70.

IV. As to section seventy thereof—

(a) “or any stone to which this section may be prescribed to apply” after “oil” in subsection (1) : and

(b) By substituting for repealed subsection (7) the following new subsection (7)—

“(7) No permit under this section shall be in respect of any greater area than may be prescribed in relation to the mining product in respect of which it is granted.” : and

Section 80.

V. By inserting after “shall” in the first line of subsection (2) of section eighty thereof the words “be in writing and shall”.

3 This Act shall expire on the date of the gazettal of a proclamation made under section eight of the *Statute Law Revision Act 1934*, effecting in the Principal Act, as from the date of such gazettal, the amendments made by this Act with such alterations, if any, as may be required to adapt the same for incorporation in the reprint of the Principal Act.
