BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Marine Act 1958*.

(2) The *Marine Act 1921*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section sixty-four of the Principal Act is amended by omitting paragraph XVI and substituting therefor the following paragraphs:—

“ XVI To let, or grant a licence to use or occupy, any wharf, work, building, or land for a term not exceeding three years, or, with the consent of the Governor, for a term not exceeding twenty years:

“ XVII To let any land on a building lease, with the consent of the Governor, for a term not exceeding ninety-nine years:”.
