**No. 22 of 1962.****AN ACT to amend the *Medical Act* 1959.**

[10 May 1962.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title  
and citation.**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Medical Act* 1962.(2) The *Medical Act* 1959, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.Provisional  
registration.**2** Section twenty-three of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after subsection (1) thereof the following subsection:—

“ (1A) Where a person who is not a British subject—

(a) holds one or more primary qualifications; and

(b) has passed a qualifying examination,

the Council may, for the purpose of enabling that person to serve as a resident medical officer in an approved hospital (within the meaning of section twenty), grant to that person a certificate of provisional registration.”.
