

MARINE.

No. 60 of 1968.

AN ACT to amend the *Marine Act 1921*.

[5 December 1968.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title
and citation.

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Marine Act 1968*.

(2) The *Marine Act 1921*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Flinders:
Number and
election of
wardens.

2 Section thirty-four A of the Principal Act is repealed and the following section is substituted therefor:—

“34A—(1) The Marine Board of Flinders shall consist of three wardens elected for a term of three years.

“(2) One warden shall retire in each year.

“(3) The warden to retire in each year shall be the one who has been longest in office without having been again elected at an ordinary election.”.

3 The third schedule to the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following words:—

“*Flinders*—The municipality of Flinders.”.

4 Section forty-seven of the Principal Act is amended by omitting therefrom the words “those of Flinders and” and substituting therefor the words “that of”.

Transitory
provisions.

5 Notwithstanding the amendments of the Principal Act made by this Act, the Marine Board of Flinders, as constituted immediately before the passing of this Act, shall continue in existence until the date of the election referred to in subsection (2) of this section and may, until that date, continue to exercise and perform its powers, functions, and duties under the Principal Act as if this Act had not been enacted.

(2) The first election of wardens of the Marine Board of Flinders shall be held, in accordance with the provisions of section thirty-nine of the Principal Act, on the date of the annual election of councillors of the municipality of Flinders to be held in the year 1969.

(3) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of section thirty-four A of the Principal Act (as enacted by section two of this Act), for the purpose of securing the rotational retirement of wardens of the Marine Board of Flinders, of the wardens elected at the first election—

- (a) the warden who obtains the largest number of primary votes at that election shall hold office for a term of three years from the date of that election;
- (b) the warden who obtains the next largest number of primary votes at that election shall hold office for a term of two years from that date; and
- (c) the remaining warden shall hold office for a term of one year from that date.

ALCOHOL AND DRUG DEPENDENCY.

No. 61 of 1968.

AN ACT to make provision with respect to the treatment and control of persons suffering from alcohol dependency or drug dependency, to bring to an end the provisions of the *Inebriates Act* 1885 and the *Inebriate Hospitals Act* 1892 and certain provisions of the *Dangerous Drugs Act* 1959, and to make provision with respect to incidental and consequential matters.

PART I. PRELIMINARY.

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Alcohol and Drug Dependency Act* 1968. Short title and commencement.

(2) This Act shall come into force on a date to be fixed by proclamation.
