AN ACT to amend the Motor Accidents (Liabilities and Compensation) Act 1973 for the purpose of making special provision with respect to vehicles registered outside the State.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Motor Accidents (Liabilities and Compensation) Amendment Act 1979*. Short title.

2—In this Act, the *Motor Accidents (Liabilities and Compensation) Act 1973** is referred to as the Principal Act. Principal Act.

Amendment of section 19 of Principal Act (Special provisions as to permitted out-of-State vehicles).

3—Section 19 of the Principal Act is amended as follows—

- (a) by omitting “ motor vehicle that is registered elsewhere than in this State and ” and substituting “ permitted out-of-State vehicle ”;
- (b) by being renumbered as subsection (1); and
- (c) by adding at the end the following subsection:—

(2) For the purposes of this section, “ a permitted out-of-State vehicle ” means any motor vehicle that, by virtue of its being registered elsewhere than in this State or of there being in force in respect of the vehicle a permit issued elsewhere than in this State, may lawfully be driven or used on public streets in this State without being registered under the *Traffic Act* 1925.

Amendment of second schedule to Principal Act (Provisions as to permitted out-of-State vehicles).

4—The second schedule to the Principal Act is amended by omitting from the heading “ MOTOR VEHICLES REGISTERED OUTSIDE THE STATE ” and substituting “ PERMITTED OUT-OF-STATE VEHICLES ”.
