AN ACT to amend the *Marine Act 1976*

[Royal Assent 17 March 1994]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title

1—This Act may be cited as the *Marine Amendment (Port of Launceston Authority 1994 Elections) Act 1994*.

Commencement

2—This Act commences on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Principal Act

3—In this Act, the *Marine Act 1976** is referred to as the Principal Act.

Section 29 amended (Qualification for and election of wardens for Launceston)

4—Section 29 of the Principal Act is amended as follows:—

- (a) by omitting from subsection (2) “An” and substituting “Subject to subsection (2A), an”;
- (b) by inserting the following subsection after subsection (2):—

(2A) An election for a warden for the Port of Launceston Authority in 1994 is to be held on a day, and at a time and place, appointed by the Minister by notice published in the *Gazette*.
