AN ACT to amend the Mining Companies Act 1884. [13 November, 1941.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:---

1 This Act may be cited as the Mining Companies Act 1941. Short title.

2 The Principal Act is hereby amended—

Section 143.

- I. By inserting at the end of the definition of "Company" in section six thereof the words "which comprises more than four persons": and
- II. As to section one hundred and forty-three thereof by inserting—
 - (a) "(1)" at the commencement: and
 - (b) "(2) No company shall carry on mining business unless it is registered under this Act or under the Companies Act 1920.

 Daily penalty: Five Pounds.".
