AN ACT to amend the *Mining Companies Act* 1884. A.D. 1941.
[13 November, 1941.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

2 The Principal Act is hereby amended—Amendment

No. 15.
Section 6.

I. By inserting at the end of the definition of “Company” in section six thereof the words “which comprises more than four persons”: and

Section 143.

II. As to section one hundred and forty-three thereof by inserting—

- (a) “(1)” at the commencement: and
- (b) “(2) No company shall carry on mining business unless it is registered under this Act or under the *Companies Act* 1920.
Daily penalty: Five Pounds.”.
