# AN ACT to amend the Magistrates Court Act 1987 [Royal Assent 10 December 1992]

**D**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows: -

#### Short title

1—This Act may be cited as the Magistrates Court Amendment Act 1992.

#### Commencement

2—This Act commences on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

## Principal Act

3—In this Act, the Magistrates Court Act 1987\* is referred to as the Principal Act.

#### Section 10A inserted

4—After section 10 of the Principal Act, the following section is inserted:—

#### **Immunities**

10A—A magistrate, in performing any function or exercising any power of the office of magistrate, has the same immunities as a puisne judge of the Supreme Court has under section 6 (1) of the Supreme Court Act 1887.
