

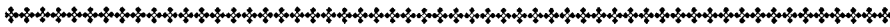

AN ACT to amend the Mental Health Services Act 1967.

[Royal Assent 3 October 1986]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Mental Health Services Amendment Act 1986*. Short title.

2—(1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the day on which this Act receives the Royal assent. Commencement.

(2) Except as provided in subsection (1), this Act shall commence on such day as may be fixed by proclamation.

Principal Act.

3—In this Act, the *Mental Health Services Act 1967** is referred to as the Principal Act.

Amendment of section 14 of Principal Act (Payments, &c., to members of boards).

4—Section 14 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (1) “in accordance with prescribed scales,” and substituting “at such rates as may from time to time be payable to officers of the mental health service under an award in force under the *Industrial Relations Act 1984* which applies to those officers.”
