AN ACT to amend the National Companies and Securities Commission (State Provisions) Act 1981.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the National Companies and Securities Short title. Commission (State Provisions) Amendment Act 1984.

Commencement. 2—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives the royal assent.

Amendment of section 8 of National Companies and Securities Commission (State Provisions) Act 1981 (Power to summon witnesses and take evidence). **3**—Section 8 (3) of the National Companies and Securities Commission (State Provisions) Act 1981* is amended by omitting "answers he will give to the questions asked him will be true" and substituting "evidence he will give will be true".
