## NEW NORFOLK WATER SUPPLY.

No. 32 of 1950.

### AN ACT to amend the *New Norfolk Water Supply Act 1938*. [17 October, 1950.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the House of Assembly in Parliament assembled as follows:—

Short title  
and citation.

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *New Norfolk Water Supply Act 1950*.

(2) The *New Norfolk Water Supply Act 1938*\* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Provision for  
water rate.

**2** Section three of the Principal Act is amended by inserting in subsection (1), after the words "one shilling", the words "and sixpence".

**3** After section four of the Principal Act the following sections are inserted:—

Borrowing  
powers of  
council.

"5. The council, during the construction, alteration, or installation of any works or appliances for the storage or distribution of water in any part of the town (in this Act referred to as "the waterworks"), may, after passing a special resolution for the purpose, as required by section one hundred and ninety of the *Local Government Act 1906*†, borrow the sum of £35,000 (in this Act called "the principal sum") to finance the waterworks.

Power of

"6. In addition to the power conferred on it by section five, the council, during the construction, alteration, or installation of the waterworks, may raise any portion of the principal sum by advances from a bank or banks by way of overdraft of the current account of the council upon the credit of the municipality; but so that, when the amount of any such overdraft at any time exceeds the sum of £5000 the council shall repay the sum of £5000 to the bank or banks concerned, and shall raise the necessary monies for

## FEDERAL JUBILEE.

### No. 33 of 1950.

AN ACT to provide for the State's taking part in the Celebration of the Jubilee of the Establishment of the Commonwealth of Australia.

[17 October, 1950.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** This Act may be cited as the *Federal Jubilee Act 1950* and shall be incorporated and read as one with the *Sesqui-centenary Act 1949\**.

Short title and incorporation.

**2** In this Act "Jubilee" means the Jubilee of the establishment of the Commonwealth of Australia.

Interpretation.

**3**—(1) It shall be the duty of the Committee—

Additional functions of Committee.

- (a) on the direction of the Governor and so far as any money necessary for the purpose has been voted by Parliament to arrange and carry out any part of the celebration of the Jubilee on behalf of the Governor;
- (b) to arrange and carry out suitable public celebrations and other proceedings in connection with the celebration of the Jubilee;
- (c) to report to the Governor, through the Minister, from time to time on the best way to carry out the purposes of this Act both in regard to proposals originating in the Committee and in regard to matters referred to it by the Governor through the Minister;
