

NEW NORFOLK WATER SUPPLY.

No. 39 of 1962.

AN ACT to amend certain enactments relating to the supply of water in New Norfolk.

[12 October 1962.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *New Norfolk Water Supply Act 1962*. Short title.

2 In this Act, unless the contrary intention appears—

Interpretation.

“New Norfolk Water Supply Acts” means the *New Norfolk Water Supply Act 1840*, the *New Norfolk Water Supply Act 1860*, the *New Norfolk Water Supply Act 1863*, the *New Norfolk Water Supply Act 1865*, and the *New Norfolk Water Supply Act 1938*;

“water district” means any water district for the time being constituted under Part XV of the *Local Government Act 1906* that comprises or contains the whole or any part of the town of New Norfolk.

3 The New Norfolk Water Supply Acts apply and have effect in relation to a water district as they apply and have effect in relation to the town of New Norfolk, and accordingly the references in those Acts to that town shall be construed as including references to a water district. Extension of New Norfolk Water Supply Acts.

4 Section three of the *New Norfolk Water Supply Act 1938* is amended— Water rates.

(a) by omitting from subsection (1) the words “one shilling and sixpence” and substituting therefor the words “two shillings and sixpence”; and

(b) by omitting from that subsection the words “: Provided that the amount of such rate shall not, in the case of any property, which is a dwelling-house, be less than ten shillings.” and substituting therefor the words “, and that water rate may be so made and levied as to provide for a minimum annual payment in respect of every property in respect of which it is payable.”.
