Registration of nurses.

Reference to mental nurses changed. 4 Mental nurses shall hereafter, for all purposes, be known as psychiatric nurses, and any reference to a mental nurse in any Act, regulation, rule, by-law, proclamation, or order-incouncil, or in any instrument or document whatsoever, whether passed, made, or executed before or after the commencement of this section, shall, by virtue of this section and without further authority, be construed and taken as a reference to a psychiatric nurse.
