

NURSES' REGISTRATION.

No. 39 of 1950.

AN ACT to amend the *Nurses' Registration Act* 1927. [31 October, 1950.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Nurses' Registration Act* 1950. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Nurses' Registration Act* 1927*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section three of the Principal Act is amended— Constitution of Nurses' Board.

(a) by omitting from subsection (2) the word “seven” and substituting therefor the word “nine”;

(b) by omitting paragraphs II. and III. of that subsection and substituting therefor the following paragraphs:—

“ II. The member of the staff of the Royal Hobart Hospital who, for the time being, is the head of, and has the supervision and direct management of, that Hospital, for the purposes of section thirty-two of the *Hospitals Act* 1918:

III. The member of the staff of the Launceston General Hospital who, for the time being, is the head of, and has the supervision and direct management of, that Hospital, for the purposes of section thirty-two of the *Hospitals Act* 1918.”;

- (c) by omitting the word "and" after paragraph IV. of that subsection;
- (d) by omitting from paragraph V. of that subsection the words "two public hospitals in Tasmania" and substituting therefor the words "the Royal Hobart Hospital and the Launceston General Hospital";
- (e) by adding after paragraph V. of that subsection the following paragraphs:—

"VI. A person appointed by the Governor (being a person registered under this Act) who is employed on the staff of an approved training institution which is situated elsewhere than in either of the cities of Hobart and Launceston: and

"VII. A person appointed by the Governor (being a person registered under this Act) who is employed on the staff of an approved training institution (not being a public hospital)."

Powers and duties of Board.

3 Section five of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by inserting after the words "Board shall" the words ", subject to the regulations,"; and
- (b) by inserting after paragraph IV. the following paragraph:—

"IVA. Issue to approved institutions training directions, supplementary to the regulations, prescribing courses of training:".

Approval of institutions for training.

4 Section nineteen of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (1) the words "the prescribed course and period of training are provided thereat" and substituting therefor the words "at that hospital or institution the prescribed course of training is provided and the training directions of the Board are complied with".

Regulations.

5 Section twenty-four of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by inserting after paragraph I. the following paragraphs:—

"IA. The conditions (including educational standard and physique) to be fulfilled by persons wishing to begin a course of training:

IB. The courses of training to be completed, before sitting for examinations conducted by the Board and before applying for registration, by persons wishing to qualify for registration:

IC. Certificates of completion of training (wholly or in part) and of attendance at an approved institution, and the persons by whom those certificates shall be given:

ID. The supervision of training at approved institutions:"; and

(b) by inserting in paragraph IV., after the word "certificates", the words "of registration".

PRICES (No. 2).

No. 40 of 1950.

AN ACT to amend the *Prices Act* 1948.

[31 October, 1950.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Prices Act (No. 2)* 1950. Short title, citation, and commencement.

(2) The *Prices Act* 1948*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the thirtieth day of October, 1950.

2 Section forty-eight of the Principal Act is repealed and the following section is substituted therefor:— Expiry of Act.

"48. This Act shall expire on the thirtieth day of November, 1950."
