NURSES' REGISTRATION

No. 73 of 1954.

AN ACT to amend the Nurses' Registration Act 1952. [21 December, 1954.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Nurses' Registration short title Act 1954.
- (2) The Nurses' Registration Act 1952 is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- **2** Section ten of the Principal Act is amended by omitting Registration from paragraph (d) of subsection (1) the word "welfare" of nurses. and substituting therefor the word "health".
 - 3 Section eleven of the Principal Act is amended—

Qualifications for registra-

- (a) by omitting from sub-paragraph (i) of paragraph tion.
 (a) of subsection (1) the word "or";
- (b) by adding at the end of that sub-paragraph the words "or, if registered under the Tasmanian Auxiliary Nursing Service Act 1949, for a period of not less than three years after being so registered;";
- (c) by omitting from sub-paragraph (iv) of that paragraph the word "welfare" (wherever occurring) and substituting therefor, in each case, the word "health";
- (d) by omitting from paragraph (c) of that subsection the words "sound health and"; and
- (e) by omitting from subsection (7) the word "welfare" (third and fourth occurring) and substituting therefor, in each case, the word "health".
