## NURSES' REGISTRATION.

AN ACT to amend the Nurses' Registration 126 June 1958.1 Act 1952.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Nurses' Registration Short title Act 1958.
- (2) The Nurses' Registration Act 1952, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
