AN ACT to amend the Nurses' Registration Act 1952.

[16 May 1974]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Nurses' Registration Act* 1974. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Nurses' Registration Act* 1952, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section 10 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (3) the words “, and no male person shall be registered as a midwifery nurse”. Registration of nurses.
