AN ACT to amend the Nurses' Registration Act 1952. [16 May 1974]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Nurses' Registration Act Short title and 1974.
- (2) The *Nurses' Registration Act* 1952, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- **2** Section 10 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from Registration subsection (3) the words ", and no male person shall be registered as a midwifery nurse".
