AN ACT to amend the *Traffic Act 1925*.  
[11 November, 1947.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title  
and citation.

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Traffic Act 1947*.

(2) The *Traffic Act 1925\**, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**2** Section forty-one of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after the words “twenty pounds” in subsection (1) the words “, or three months’ imprisonment”.

## NURSES’ REGISTRATION.

AN ACT to amend the *Nurses’ Registration Act 1927*.  
[11 November, 1947.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title  
and citation.

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Nurses’ Registration Act (No. 2) 1947*.

(2) The *Nurses’ Registration Act 1927\**, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**2** Section ten of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsections:—

Qualifications  
for regis-  
tration.

“(7) Any person who, at the commencement of this subsection, is the holder of a certificate in child welfare nursing, issued, after examination, by the body known as the Child Welfare Association of Tasmania, shall be entitled, upon payment of the prescribed fee, to be registered as a child welfare nurse under this Act without undergoing the prescribed course of training for child welfare nurses.

(8) Any person who, at the commencement of this subsection, is the holder of a certificate in tuberculosis nursing, issued, after examination, by the committee of the Tasmanian Sanatorium, shall be entitled, upon payment of the prescribed fee, to be registered as a tuberculosis nurse under this Act, without undergoing the prescribed course of training for tuberculosis nurses.”.

### 11 GEO. VI. No. 56.

#### AN ACT to amend the *Towns Act 1934*. [11 November, 1947.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Towns Act 1947*.

Short title  
and citation.

(2) The *Towns Act 1934*\*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**2** Section thirty-six of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after paragraph IX. of subsection (1) the following paragraph:—

Powers of  
council:  
removal of  
ferns, &c.,  
by owners.

“IX.A Compel the owners of any lands abutting on any right-of-way, lane, or passage to remove any ferns, weeds, rubbish, scrub, undergrowth, or dried grass from such lands:”.

**3** Section forty-eight D of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (9) the words “Director of Public Health”, and substituting therefor the words “Town and Country Planning Commissioner”.
