AN ACT to amend the Nurses' Registration Act 1952.

[Royal Assent 22 November 1984]

RE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—This Act may be cited as the Nurses' Registration Amendment Short title. Act 1984.
 - 2—This Act shall commence on 1st December 1984.

3—In this Act, the Nurses' Registration Act 1952* is referred to as the Principal Act.

Amendment of section 11 of Principal Act Qualifications for registration or enrolment).

- **4**—Section 11 (1) (a) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subparagraph (i) and substituting the following subparagraph:-
 - (i) general nursing—
 - (A) has attended the practice, lectures, and training provided by an approved training institution;
 - (B) has completed, and passed examinations in, an approved course at the school of nursing of an approved training institution, and is the holder of a diploma or degree issued by that institution in respect of that course;
