AN ACT to amend the Officers of Parliament Salaries Act 1927. [28 September, 1951.]

RE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1-(1) This Act may be cited as the Officers of Parliament short title and citation. Salaries Act 1951.

(2) The Officers of Parliament Salaries Act 1927*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section three of the Principal Act is amended by insert-salaries ing after subsection (1) thereof the following subsection :- payable to "(1A) There shall be paid to the Deputy Chairman of the schedule. Committees of the Legislative Council, while acting as Chairman of Committees of the Council during any period during which the Chairman of Committees acts as Deputy-President of the Council, a salary calculated at the rate of one hundred and seventy-five pounds per annum.".

3 The Principal Act is amended by omitting from the Schedule. schedule thereto the numerals "175" and substituting therefor the numerals "250".
