AN ACT to provide for the Payment of a Pension to *Dorothy Mabel Ogilvie*, widow of the Honourable *Albert George Ogilvie*, late Premier of Tasmania. [27 July, 1939.]

WHEREAS the Honourable *Albert George Ogilvie*, lately Premier of Tasmania, rendered signal and outstanding service to this State: AND WHEREAS it is fitting that some provision should be made for his widow in recognition of the valuable service so rendered by him and as an appropriate memorial thereof:

Preamble.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**2**—(1) There shall be payable and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue to *Dorothy Mabel Ogilvie*, widow of the Honourable *Albert George Ogilvie*, late Premier of Tasmania, an annual pension of two hundred and fifty pounds during widowhood.

(2) Such pension shall be payable monthly as from the twelfth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine.

**3** The Governor shall issue his warrant to the Treasurer for the payment of the pension payable under this Act, and the same shall thereupon be paid by the Treasurer to the said *Dorothy Mabel Ogilvie* or to such other person as she shall, by writing under her hand, appoint to recover the same.
