BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative
Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled,
as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Prison Act* 1944.

2 Section six of the *Prison Act* 1908* is amended by deleting the words "in this State, or in such part thereof as in the licence mentioned".
