

**PENSIONERS (HEATING ALLOWANCES)**

ANALYSIS

1. Short title and citation.
2. Interpretation.

AN ACT to amend the Pensioners (Heating Allowances) Act 1971.
[11 December 1975]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Pensioners (Heating Allowances) Act 1975*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Pensioners (Heating Allowances) Act 1971* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Interpretation.

2 Section 2 (1) of the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by inserting in paragraph (a) of the definition of “pensioner” after the words “age pension” the words “, a widows’ pension,”; and

(b) by inserting after that paragraph the following paragraphs:—

“(aa) a benefit from the State as a woman who has the custody, care, and control of a child in respect of which benefit the State receives financial assistance as a participating State under the *State Grants (Deserted Wives) Act* 1968 of the Commonwealth;

“(ab) a benefit under Part IV^{AAA} of the *Social Services Act* 1947-1975 of the Commonwealth as a woman who has the custody, care, and control of a child;”.
