

PHARMACY AMENDMENT ACT 1981

AN ACT to amend the Pharmacy Act 1908 to provide for financing the pre-registration education of graduates.

[Royal Assent 17 December 1981]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—This Act may be cited as the Pharmacy Amendment Act 1981. Short title.
- **2**—This Act shall commence on the date on which it receives the Commence Royal Assent.

Principal Act.

3—In this Act, the *Pharmacy Act* 1908* is referred to as the Principal Act.

Amendment of section 24 of Principal Act (Board to control examinations in practical pharmacy).

- **4**—Section 24 of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after subsection (1) the following subsection:—
 - (1A) The Board shall have power to conduct pre-registration education of graduates with respect to practical pharmacy, and the conducting of that education is one of the purposes of this Act referred to in section 37.

Amendment of section 36 of Principal Act (Fees). **5**—Section 36 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (1) "for the purposes of this Act".

Amendment of section 37 of Principal Act (Penalties and fees to be paid to the Registrar).

- 6—Section 37 of the Principal Act is amended as follows:—
 - (a) by inserting "(1)" before "All penalties"; and
 - (b) by adding the following subsection as subsection (2) of that section:—
 - (2) The funds of the Board may be expended by the Board for the purposes of this Act.
