AN ACT to amend the Pesticides Act 1968

[Royal Assent 26 May 1994]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title

1—This Act may be cited as the *Pesticides Amendment Act* 1994.

Commencement

2—This Act commences on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Principal Act

3—In this Act, the *Pesticides Act 1968** is referred to as the Principal Act.

Section 9 substituted

4—Section 9 of the Principal Act is repealed and the following section is substituted:—

Period of registration

9—The registration of a substance or an organism under this Part is to be for a period not exceeding 12 months and ceases to have effect, unless it is renewed or further renewed, at the end of 30 June following its registration or renewal.
