**AN ACT to amend the Pensioners (Heating Allowances) Act 1971
for the purpose of making further provision with respect to the
eligibility of pensioners for the grant of heating allowances.**

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and
House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Pensioners (Heating Allowances) Amendment Act 1981*. Short title.

2—This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on 1st October 1981.

3—Section 3 of the *Pensioners (Heating Allowances) Act 1971** is amended as follows:—

(a) by omitting paragraph (d) of subsection (1) and substituting the following paragraph:—

(d) the liquid assets of—

- (i) the pensioner do not exceed \$1 750;
- (ii) the pensioner and his spouse do not exceed in total \$2 750; or
- (iii) any other person referred to in paragraph (b) do not exceed \$1 750.

(b) by omitting paragraphs (a) and (b) of subsection (4) and substituting the following paragraphs:—

(a) the income of any of the persons referred to in paragraph (c) of that subsection exceeds \$10 a week; or

(b) the liquid assets of—

- (i) the pensioner exceed \$1 750;
- (ii) the pensioner and his spouse exceed in total \$2 750; and
- (iii) any other person referred to in paragraph (b) of that subsection exceed \$1 750,
