AN ACT to ratify and confirm certain Repeals and Amendments made by Proclamation under the provisions of the *Statute Law Revision Act 1934*.
 [10 August, 1936.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS the Governor is empowered under the provisions of the *Statute Law Revision Act 1934* to make certain amendments and to repeal certain enactments for the purposes of that Act :

And whereas, by proclamations gazetted on the twenty-fifth day of February, the twenty-fourth day of March, the fifth day of May, the thirtieth day of June, and the twenty-first day of July, respectively, of the present year, the repeals and amendments set forth in Parts I. and II. of the schedule respectively were made by the Governor under the said Act :

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And whereas, in certain instances, doubts may arise as to whether the said repeals and amendments, or some of them, are within the scope of the authority conferred by the said Act, and it is desirable to ratify and confirm the same and to remove any doubt as to their validity and effect :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

Short title.

1 This Act may be cited as the *Proclamations Confirmation Act 1936*.

Confirmation of repeals and amendments in schedule.

2—(1) The repeals set forth in Part I of the schedule, and the amendments of the several enactments enumerated in Part II. of the schedule, as set forth in the fourth column thereof, are hereby ratified and confirmed, and are declared to have been lawfully and validly made, and all such repeals and amendments shall have, and be deemed to have had, effect according to the tenor thereof.

(2) The repeals and amendments set forth in the schedule, comprising a consolidation of the repeals and amendments made by the several proclamations recited in the preamble, with the corrections of earlier proclamations by later proclamations embodied therein, shall be deemed to express the combined effect of all the said proclamations, and in the event of any accidental variance, not being a mere typographical error or misprint, being found to exist between the amendments in the schedule and the corresponding amendments contained in the proclamations, the amendments in the schedule shall prevail, and shall be construed as correcting the proclamations as from the commencement thereof.
