AN ACT to repeal the Wood-pulp and Paper Industry Encouragement Act 1926 and Associated Pulp and Paper Mills Act 1936

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title

1—This Act may be cited as the *Pulpwood Concession* Legislation Repeal Act 1995.

Commencement

2—This Act commences on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Repeal

3—The Wood-pulp and Paper Industry Encouragement Act 1926 and the Associated Pulp and Paper Mills Act 1936 are repealed.
