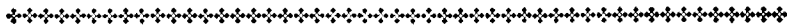

No. 43.**2** The Principal Act is hereby amended—

- I. By inserting at the end of subsection (1) of section one hundred and twenty-two thereof the following proviso—

“ Provided that the Minister, on the request in writing of the local authority, may grant permission for the building of a dwelling-house in a sparsely settled bush area if the same has such access to a public street as in the opinion of the local authority is sufficient in the circumstances of the particular case ”: and

Section 137.

- II. As to section one hundred and thirty-seven thereof by deleting the numeral “1” at the beginning of the first paragraph of subsection (9), and the word “or” after that paragraph; and by expunging paragraph II. of that subsection.
