**2**—(1) Section ninety-eight of the Principal Act is hereby amended—

Section 112

(2) Section one hundred and twelve of the Principal Act is hereby amended by adding after subsection (3) the following new subsection (4)—

“ (4) Any such regulations may prescribe any conditions and restrictions with respect to the means of disposal of dead bodies otherwise than by burial or cremation; as to the period a body may be retained after death on any premises, or with respect to embalming or preservation; which may appear to be desirable in the interests of public health or public safety.”.
