**AN ACT to amend the Public Health Act 1962.**

[27 May 1976]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1—**(1) This Act may be cited as the *Public Health Act 1976*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Public Health Act 1962*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**2** Section 57 of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by omitting from subsection (3) (a) the words “ the Secretary for Local Government and by him to ”; and
- (b) by omitting from subsection (3) (a) the words “ the Minister ” (second occurring) and substituting the word “ him ”.

**3** Section 120A of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by omitting from subsection (2) (a) the words “ the Secretary for Local Government and by him to ”; and
- (b) by omitting from subsection (2) (a) the words “ the Minister ” (second occurring) and substituting the word “ him ”.
