1. Short title and citation.
2. Setting of traps in city or town prohibited.



AN ACT to amend the Police Offences Act 1935.

[21 November 1974]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Police Offences Act 1974*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Police Offences Act 1935*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 After Division II of Part VI of the Principal Act the following Division is inserted:—

Division IIA—Setting of traps

Setting of traps
in city or town
prohibited.

“ 46A— No person shall, in such city or town or such part of a city or town as may be prescribed for the purposes of this section, set a steel-jawed trap, or cause or permit such a trap to be set.

Penalty: \$100.”.
