AN ACT to repeal the Police Offences (Contraceptives) Act 1941.

[21 June 1976]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Police Offences (Contra-Short title and ceptives) (Repeal) Act 1976.

(2) This Act shall commence on a date to be fixed by proclamation.
