 35A—Tattooing, &c., of persons under the age of 18 years.

AN ACT to amend the Police Offences Act 1935.

[Royal Assent 17 April 1985]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—This Act may be cited as the Police Offences Amendment Act Short title. 1985.
- **2**—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives the Commence royal assent.

Principal Act.

3—In this Act, the *Police Offences Act* 1935* is referred to as the Principal Act.

Insertion in Principal Act of new section 35a.

Tattooing, &c., of persons under the age of 18 years.

4—The Principal Act is amended by inserting after section 35 the following section:—

35A—Any person who performs any tattooing or like process of any person under the age of 18 years shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: \$100 or 6 months' imprisonment or both.
