AN ACT to amend the Police Offences Act 1935.

[Royal Assent 14 November 1985]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Police Offences Amendment Act* Short title. (No. 2) 1985.

2—(1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the day Commence- on which this Act receives the Royal assent. ment.

(2) Except as provided in subsection (1), this Act shall commence on such day as may be fixed by proclamation.

Principal Act.

3—In this Act, the *Police Offences Act 1935** is referred to as the Principal Act.

Substitution of section 46A of Principal Act.

4—Section 46A of the Principal Act is repealed and the following section is substituted:—

Setting of steel-jawed traps in certain areas prohibited.

46A—(1) A person shall not set a steel-jawed trap, or cause or permit a steel-jawed trap to be set—

(a) in any city or town, or in any part of a city or town, that is prescribed for the purposes of this section;

or

(b) within 100 metres of any dwelling-house without the consent of the occupier of that dwelling-house.

Penalty: \$100.

(2) Regulations made for the purpose of prescribing a city or town or part of a city or town for the purposes of subsection (1) may adopt, either wholly or in part, by reference any provision of a regulation from time to time in force under any Act.
