

2. Amendment of 8 Geo. V. No. 49, s. 3.

AN ACT to amend the *Places of Public* ^{A.D.} **1935.**
Entertainment Act 1917. [19 August, 1935.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Places of Public Entertainment Act 1935.* Short title.

2 The Principal Act is hereby amended by inserting after the word “contest)” in the definition of “public entertainment” in section three thereof the words “to which persons are admitted on payment or” ^{Amendment of 8 Geo. V. No. 49, s. 3.}
