PLUMBERS' REGISTRATION.

AN ACT to amend the *Plumbers' Registration*Act 1951. [30 June 1967.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Plumbers' Registration Act* 1967.
- (2) The *Plumbers' Registration Act* 1951, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

- "(1) Where, in or in connection with the carrying out of certain cases. plumbing work in a prescribed area, a person who holds a subsisting certificate of registration or a subsisting interim certificate of registration under this Act contravenes any provision of—
 - (a) the Building Regulations; or
 - (b) the by-laws of the local authority,

relating to the carrying out of plumbing work or causes or allows any other person to contravene any such provision, that local authority may by order prohibit the person holding that certificate from engaging in or undertaking plumbing work in such area or areas as may be specified in the order in accordance with subsection (1A) of this section, either indefinitely or during such period as may be specified in the order.".
