No. 33 of 1977

AN ACT to amend the Police Regulation Act 1898.

[28 April 1977]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Police Regulation Act* 1977. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Police Regulation Act* 1898*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section 9A of the Principal Act is omitted and the following sections substituted:—

“ 9A—(1) The Governor may appoint two persons to be Assistant Commissioners and the persons so appointed shall assist the Commissioner in the control and superintendence of the police force and either of the Assistant Commissioners may be appointed to act as Deputy Commissioner during any illness, suspension, or absence of the Deputy Commissioner, and while so acting, shall have the powers and perform the duties of the Deputy Commissioner.

“(2) Applications shall be called for every appointment other than an appointment to act as Deputy Commissioner referred to in subsection (1).

“ 9B The Commissioner, Deputy Commissioner, and Assistant Commissioners respectively shall each retire from office on attaining the age of 65 years.

“ 9C An appointment made by the Governor pursuant to section 8, 9, or 9A is not subject to appeal under this Act.”.

3 Section 49 of the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by inserting after “ Deputy-Commissioner ” (first occurring) “ or Assistant Commissioner ”; and

(b) by omitting “ or Deputy Commissioner ” and substituting “, Deputy-Commissioner, or Assistant Commissioner ”.
