

PHYSIOTHERAPISTS' REGISTRATION AMENDMENT ACT 1982

AN ACT to amend the Physiotherapists' Registration Act 1951 for the purpose of enabling registered chiropractors to carry out physiotherapeutic treatment without having to be registered under that Act.

[Royal Assent 28 October 1982]

RE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the Physiotherapists' Registration short title. Amendment Act 1982.

Commencement. No. 41

2—This Act shall commence on the same day as that fixed under section 2 (3) of the *Chiropractors Registration Act* 1982.

Amendment of section 24 of Physiotherapists Registration Act 1951 (Non-application of Act to certain persons).

- **3**—Section 24 (2) of the *Physiotherapists' Registration Act* 1951* is amended as follows:—
 - (a) by omitting from paragraph (b) "persons; or" and substituting "persons;";
 - (b) by omitting from paragraph (c) "Act." and substituting "Act; or";
 - (c) by inserting the following paragraph after paragraph (c):—
 - (d) being a person registered as a chiropractor under the *Chiropractors Registration Act* 1982, applies any physiotherapeutic treatment in the course of practising chiropractic within the meaning of that Act.

Expiry.

4—This Act shall expire at the expiration of the period of 2 years beginning on the commencement of section 2, and after that date the *Physiotherapists' Registration Act* 1951 shall have effect as if this Act had never been enacted.
